## 1. Getting started



### Set up your computer

### Check your internet connection

Does it meet our minimum speed requirements?  
Have you checked whether there are any data limits?  
Have you checked whether there are any services running which may affect your connection?  
Are you able to connect using an ethernet cable rather than via Wi-Fi?  
Have you checked whether you would qualify for grant funding to improve your internet connectivity?



### Set up your webcam

Do you have a suitable internal or external webcam? Have you positioned it correctly?



### Set up your microphone/speakers/headset

Do you have suitable microphone/speaker setup or external headset?



### Set up your UWTSD password

Have you changed your password from the one that was automatically generated? Have you read and agreed to our Acceptable use policy? Have you setup Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) to secure your IT account?



### Download and install necessary software

Have you installed Microsoft 365 applications?  
Have you installed Microsoft Teams?  
Have you installed adequate anti-virus software?



### Install the mobile apps

Have you installed the UWTSD Student HWB app?  
Have you installed the Outlook Email app?  
Have you installed the Microsoft Authenticator app for MFA?
